Recitals

Each party is entering into this agreement with the intent to abide by its terms to the extent that this serves the best performance and interests of the applicants.

This contract, from the moment it is signed by the artist in its entirety, instantly acquires artistic value as a piece of art. Furthermore, it legitimizes and protects the performance of the artist throughout the validity period, strictly bound by the underlying articles.

Contractual body

#1 The contract may have a duration of a minimum of 30 days to a maximum linked to the artistic needs, decided and bound in Article #2.

- #2 In order to establish the adoption time, at least one official engagement (virtual or personally) must be undertaken at the beginning of the actual contract. In which it will be discussed together about the site of residence, the possible project to be developed and the compilation of the contract in detail, in the possible options described and reported on the same.
- #3 The contract can be revoked at any time but after consultation with the artist and after explanation of the changed needs.
- #4 The adopter undertakes to respect the contractual constraints described on all articles with the possibility of modifying them according to the right cause and after consultation with the artist in the specific space of the contract.

Contractual constraints

#5 The adopter undertakes to guarantee the legitimate minimum security for the adopted artist, which consist of:

Satisfy daily meals and place that gives the possibility of accommodation and can cover the common physical needs, following the form and duration stipulated in article # 2.

#6 The adopter undertakes to consult the artist before defining the terms of the art trade and the possible goods stipulated by the contractual obligation. By condemning that the very act of adopting an arista, involves participation and co-creation in making a work of art possible: the same contract.

#7 The artist is not obliged to comply with any type of request received from his guarantor.
